SYNAXIS OF JOHN THE BAPTIST



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## Acts of the Apostles 19:1-8

Prokeimenon. Grave Mode Psalm 63.11,1

The righteous shall rejoice in the Lord.

Verse: Oh God, hear my cry.

The reading is from Acts of the Apostles 19:1-8

In those days, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul passed through the upper country and came to Ephesus. There he found some disciples. And he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" And they said, "No, we have never even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." And he said, "Into what then were you baptized?" They said, "Into John's baptism." And Paul said, "John baptized with the baptism of repentance, telling the people to believe in the one who was to come after him, that is, Jesus." On hearing this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came on them; and they spoke with tongues and prophesied. There were about twelve of them in all. And he entered the synagogue and for three months spoke boldly, arguing and pleading about the kingdom of God.

Έν ταῖς ἡμεραῖς ἐκείναις, ἐγένετο δέ, ἐν τῷ τὸν Ἀπολλὼ είναι έν Κορίνθω, Παῦλον διελθόντα τὰ ἀνωτερικὰ μέρη έλθεῖν εἰς Ἐφεσον καὶ εύρών τινας μαθητάς εἶπεν πρὸς αὐτούς, Εί πνεῦμα ἄγιον ἐλάβετε πιστεύσαντες; Οί δὲ εἶπονΝ πρὸς αὐτόν, Άλλ' οὐδὲΝ εἰ πνεῦμα ἄγιόν ἐστιν, ήκούσαμεν. Εἶπέν τε πρὸς αὐτούς, Εἰς τί οὖν ἐβαπτίσθητε; Οἱ δὲ εἶπον, Εἰς τὸ Ἰωάννου βάπτισμα. Εἶπεν δὲ Παῦλος, Ίωάννης μὲν ἐβάπτισεν βάπτισμα μετανοίας, τῷ λαῷ λέγων είς τὸν ἐρχόμενον μετ' αὐτὸν ἵνα πιστεύσωσιν, τοῦτ' ἔστιν, εἰς τὸν Χριστὸν Ἰησοῦν. Ἀκούσαντες δὲ έβαπτίσθησαν είς τὸ ὄνομα τοῦ κυρίου Ἰησοῦ. Καὶ έπιθέντος αὐτοῖς τοῦ Παύλου τὰς χεῖρας, ἦλθεν τὸ πνεῦμα έπ' αὐτούς, ἐλάλουν τε γλώσσαις ἄγιον προεφήτευον. Ήσαν δὲ οἱ πάντες ἄνδρες ὡσεὶ δεκαδύο. Είσελθών δὲ είς τὴν συναγωγὴν ἐπαρρησιάζετο, ἐπὶ μῆνας τρεῖς διαλεγόμενος καὶ πείθων τὰ περὶ τῆς βασιλείας τοῦ θεοῦ.



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
# The Gospel According to John 1:29-34

At that time, John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks before me, for he was before me.' I myself did not know him; but for this I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel." And John bore witness, "I saw the Spirit descend as a dove from heaven, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him; but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'He on whom you see the Spirit descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.' And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."

Τῷ καιρῷ ἐκείνῳ, βλέπει ὁ Ἰωάννης τὸν Ἰησοῦν έρχόμενον πρός αὐτὸν καὶ λέγει· ἴδε ὁ ἀμνὸς τοῦ Θεοῦ ὁ αἴρων τὴν ἁμαρτίαν τοῦ κόσμου. οδτός έστι περί οδ έγω εἶπον· όπίσω μου ἔρχεται ἀνὴρ δς ἔμπροσθέν μου γέγονεν, ὅτι πρῶτός μου ην. κάγὼ οὐκ ήδειν αὐτόν, ἀλλ' ἵνα φανερωθη τῷ Ἰσραήλ, διὰ τοῦτο ἦλθον ἐγὰ ἐν τῷ ὕδατι βαπτίζων. καὶ ἐμαρτύρησεν Ἰωάννης λέγων ὅτι τεθέαμαι τὸ Πνεῦμα καταβαῖνον ὡς περιστερὰν έξ οὐρανοῦ, καὶ ἔμεινεν ἐπ' αὐτόν. κάγὼ οὐκ ήδειν αὐτόν, ἀλλ' ὁ πέμψας με βαπτίζειν ἐν ύδατι, ἐκεῖνός μοι εἶπεν ἐφ' ὃν ἂν ἴδης τὸ Πνεῦμα καταβαῖνον καὶ μένον ἐπ' αὐτόν, οδτός έστιν ὁ βαπτίζων ἐν Πνεύματι 'Αγίφ. κάγὼ έώρακα καὶ μεμαρτύρηκα ὅτι οδτός ἐστίν ὁ υίὸς τοῦ Θεοῦ.

#### Resurrectional Apolytikion in the Plagal Second Mode

When the angelic powers appeared at Your tomb, and those who guarded You became as though dead. And standing by Your sepulcher was Mary, seeking Your pure sacred body. For You did vanquish Hades, and uncorrupted by its touch, You came unto the virgin women, bestowing the gift of life. O You Who rose from the dead, we give glory to You!

#### Apolytikion of Epiphany, Mode 1

By Thy baptism O Lord in the river Jordan, worship to the Trinity has shown its appearance! For the voice of the Father came forth to Thee with the testimony, naming Thee beloved Son. And the Spirit, in the likeness of a dove, confirming the truth of the Word. Wherefore, Thou who didst come and lighten the world, O Lord, glory to Thee!

For the Forerunner, Mode 2

The memory of the just is observed with hymns of praise; for you suffices the testimony of the Lord, O Forerunner. You have proved to be truly more ven'rable than the Prophets, since you were granted to baptize in the river the One whom they proclaimed. Therefore, when for the truth you had contested, rejoicing, to those in Hades you preached the Gospel, that God was manifested in the flesh, and takes away the sin of the world, and grants to us the great mercy.


### Apolytikion for the Church in the Plagal First Mode
