Άδελφοί, ὀφείλομεν δὲ ἡμεῖς οἱ δυνατοὶ τὰ άσθενήματα τῶν ἀδυνάτων βαστάζειν, καὶ μὴ έαυτοῖς ἀρέσκειν. Έκαστος ἡμῶν τῷ πλησίον άρεσκέτω είς τὸ ἀγαθὸν πρὸς οἰκοδομήν. Καὶ γὰρ Χριστός ούχ ἑαυτῷ ἤρεσεν, ἀλλά, καθὼς Ò γέγραπται, Οί όνειδισμοί τῶν ὀνειδιζόντων σε έπέπεσον έπ' έμέ. At that time, as Jesus passed by, two blind men followed him, crying aloud, "Have mercy on us, Son of David." When he entered the house, the blind men came to him; and Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to him, "Yes, Lord." Then he touched their eyes, saying, "According to your faith be it done to you." And their eyes were opened. And Jesus sternly charged them, "See that no one knows it." 
